The Edmonton Pops Orchestra combines music, dance, and storytelling to create dynamic and intimate concert experiences with original arrangements of jazz, classical, pop, and Broadway! The result is music that is undeniably fresh and distinctly local.

The Orchestra has also recognized for their innovative community outreach efforts. Students and young artists who have worked with Edmonton Pops have gone on to perform in major orchestras, with Disney, and on Broadway. Since 2017, the Edmonton Composers Competition has awarded a local composer with a prize and the opportunity to have an original piece performed at the Johann Strauss Foundation's annual ball.

The Edmonton Pops Orchestra completed its first official tour in February 2023, performing at theatres across Alberta and Saskatchewan with a heartfelt original story, eccentric cast of characters, and iconic songs from Broadway!

Michael Clark is the artistic director of the Edmonton Pops Orchestra. Michael is a composer, director, horn player, and keyboardist with a passion for storytelling and community building.

Under Michael's leadership, the Edmonton Pops Orchestra has forged partnerships with performer organizations like Shelley's Dance Company and Straight Edge Theatre, and venues like the Fairmont Hotel Macdonald and Jeanne & Peter Lougheed Performing Arts Centre.

In 2019, Michael directed the world premiere of his original musical *Once Upon a Frost* at Festival Place.

Since 2022, Michael has also served as the Music Director of the Edmonton Philharmonic Orchestra.

The Irish Rovers, Canadian music veterans, have entertained audiences for over 60 years, gaining fans across generations. In 2022, they reached Spotify's Viral Top 50 in the US and UK/Ireland, and released a new album, *No End In Sight*, featuring a refreshed version of their 1977 hit "The Wellerman."

In 2025, they embark on a Canadian tour, performing fan-picked hits, new songs, and sharing stories from their long career. Before the tour, they'll finish *The Belfast Sessions* with producer Donal O'Connor, hoping to offer the new album during their shows. Their 2022 single "Hey Boys Sing Us a Song," written by co-founder George Millar, was nominated for 2023 Canadian Folk Music Awards' Single of the Year.

The Irish Rovers achieved international fame in 1967 with their hit *The Unicorn*, written by Shel Silverstein, and have since enjoyed 15 more chart successes. They've hosted three international TV series and represented Canada at five World Expos. Celebrating their 50th anniversary, they returned to television with special programs.

Honored for their contributions to Irish music, they continue to tour, release albums, and connect with fans worldwide. Dublin's EPIC Museum has recognized the Rovers as "one of Ireland's greatest émigrés."

### **Susan Aglukark - This Child 30th Anniversary Tour**

Inuk singer/songwriter Susan Aglukark is one of Canada's most unique artists and a leading voice in Canadian music. She blends the Inuktitut, indigenous and English languages with contemporary pop music arrangements to tell the stories of her fellow people, the Inuit of Arctic Canada and her fellow indigenous groups. The emotional depth and honesty of her lyrics; her pure, clear voice and themes of hope, spirit and encouragement have captivated and inspired listeners from all walks of life. Susan was invited into the Order of Canada and was presented her Officer of the Order of Canada award in September of 2005 for her contribution both musically and as a workshop facilitator and mentor in the indigenous community. Susan was awarded the Governor General's Lifetime Artistic Achievement Award in June of 2016 and 2022 Juno Humanitarian Award.

Awards include: 4 Juno Awards, several Juno nominations, the first-ever Aboriginal Achievement Award in Arts & Entertainment, the Canadian Country Music Association's Vista Rising Star Award and several other CCM A nominations, Susan has honorary doctorates of Law from the University of Alberta where she also worked for three years as Distinguished Scholar in residence, Susan also received an honorary law degree from Calgary University, an Honorary Doctorate of Fine Arts from the Lethbridge University, a Doctor of Letters from the Laurentian University and an honorary Doctorate of Laws from the University of Toronto.

Susan is founder and program developer of the Arctic Rose Foundation, and she has released her newest album "The Crossing".
