## The Impossible Has Already Happened

**The Impossible Has Already Happened** brings together two nation's stories of water amid a global climate crisis. Choreographers **Jennifer Mascall** (Canada) and **Claire O'Neil** (NZ) investigate the power and purpose of water. Water sustains, nourishes, disrupts and dazzles our planet. It draws parallels to our flowing lives, to stagnated situations, and presence of being. With a sense of urgency, this work highlights our precious natural resource and all it can achieve.
